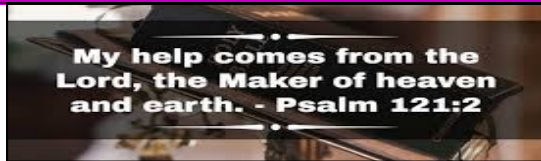


# SHILOH NEWSLETTER

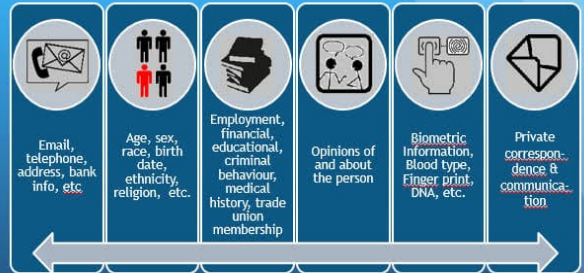
# POPI ACT

DEAR PARENTS, PLEASE NOTE THAT ALTHOUGH THE SCHOOL POSTS PICTURES OF OUR LEARNERS, SCHOOL EVENTS AND FIELD TRIPS, IT IS ONLY DONE SO FOR OUR NEWSLETTER PURPOSES AND SENT TO THE PARENTS OF OUR LEARNERS FOR PERUSAL. PLEASE KEEP THE POPI ACT IN MIND WHEN SHARING OR FORWARDING ANY PERSONAL PHOTOS OR INFORMATION OF OTHER LEARNERS AND STAFF MEMBERS



The POPI Act sets out the minimum standards regarding accessing and 'processing' of any personal information belonging to another. The Act defines 'processing' as collecting, receiving, recording, organizing, retrieving, or the use, distribution or sharing of any such information.

## What is personal information?



A higher degree of protection is given to special personal information under POPI given the highly sensitive nature of such information. Special personal information includes: Information concerning a child; religious or philosophical beliefs; race or ethnic origin; trade union membership; political opinions; health; biometrical information; sexual life; criminal behaviour.

This is a compulsory outing for term 1 for the entire school (All grades included)

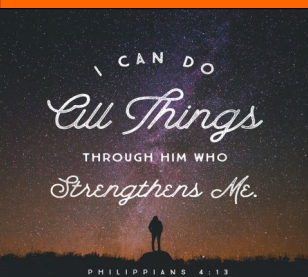
All staff (admin/finance/teachers) will be attending.
